We welcome today the Right Reverend Paul Mason, Bishop for the Forces, and to the representatives of the Royal Navy who will be joining us at our celebration of Mass this morning at 10.00am.

The Catholic Bishopric of the Forces differs from any other diocese in that it is not aligned along geographical boundaries but encompasses anywhere in the world that United Kingdom military personnel are serving or deployed.

Bishop Mason was ordained to the priesthood in July 1998. He was Ordained an Auxiliary Bishop for the Archdiocese of Southwark in St George's Cathedral on 31 May 2016, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. On 9 July 2018, Pope Francis appointed Bishop Mason the eighth Bishop of the Forces.

All are welcome to join Bishop Paul and members of the Royal Navy who are hosting a reception in the Cathedral garden afterwards.

It was with sadness the Bishop has heard of the death of Sr Catherine, who died in Nazareth House yesterday. Sister has served the Diocese with great generosity over the years, most recently in the Cathedral parish.
