Sunday 11th November is the centenary of the end of the First World War. To mark this special occasion a lone piper will play 'Battle's O'er' at 6.00am followed by a Mass for the Faithful Departed at 10.00am. At 7.05pm the Cathedral and over a thousand other churches across the country will ring their bells as part of 'Ringing Out for Peace.'

The Cathedral will create a Garden of Remembrance in the Chapel of St. George. From this Sunday and throughout November you will be able to purchase a Poppy Cross for £2, write the name of the soul you wish to be prayed for, and place it in the Garden.

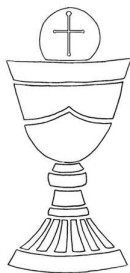
