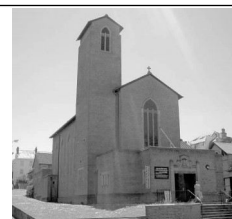

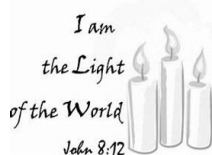


Christmas Fayre

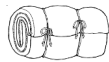
CHILDREN'S LITURGY ON SUNDAYS
