England will be re-dedicated as the 'Dowry of Mary' on the 29th March this year, with celebrations in every diocese and many parishes across the country. This is an important moment for our country at a time when we increasingly need the prayers of Mary, Our Lady of Walsingham and the Mother of God Bishop Mark will be Celebrating in the Cathedral at 11-45 , Please come and join us.
